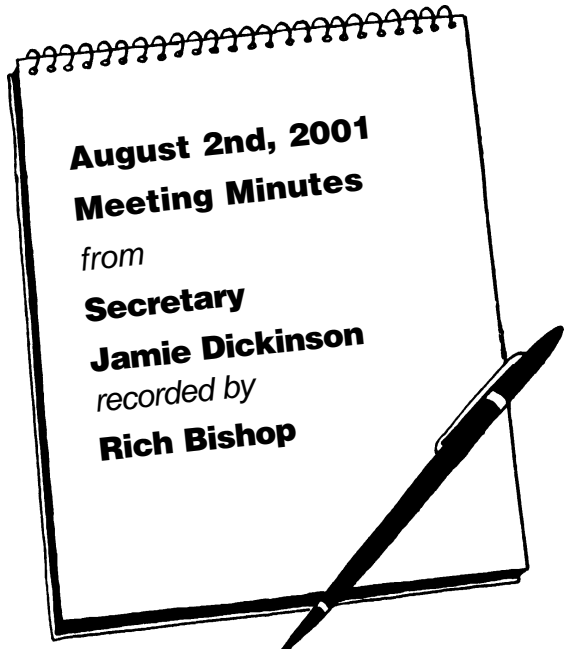
Jim Greeley in his first year as a club member turned in another impressive performance as a non-boater with his third place finish.
