Fish Talk – Finesse Tubes



Frank Rosetti provided tips on tube fishing.

 > Generally use Gitzit tubes and tube jigs rigged on a 7'
M to MH with an XF tip, a
2500 series reel and 8lb
Fluorocarbon.

 Most members use a palomar knot to tie the tube jig.

> A simple rule of thumb for jig weight.

1/8oz – 8ft or less. 1/4oz – up to 20ft. 3/8oz – greater than 20ft.

 > With wind/current err on the side of a heavier jig.
Bottom contact is key.

 Present with a long cast and slow drag along the bottom. Watch your line for soft pickups.
