
Again, congratulations to Bill Swinton and Felix Ortiz for their great catch. We hope to hear from you guys at our meeting on how you did so well in those tough conditions.

NYSBCF - Paul Pflieger: Nothing new to report.


Lunker Pool - Charlie Curcurito: \$15 BY THE FIRST POINTS TOURNAMENT! GET IN!!!



Legislative Action - George Locke: DEC is looking at installing a boat launch at Round Lake. George attended at meeting in the town to support the new boat ramp. There was talk of horsepower restrictions, etc. Rob Farantino a DEC biologist says he will have no horsepower restriction, but will instead be a speed limit. The launch is projected to be completed by 2013.

Lake George is looking at installing boat washes, and gates at all public boat launches on the lake. The Lake George Association is spearheading this, because of envasive species concerns. Specifically the Asian Clam. As a club, we will write a letter AGAINST these types of restrictions on our access to the New York State lake. We will also look at possibly attending some meetings. These are the most important types of actions we can take to protect our freedom as fishermen.
